Emergency housing for homeless families

Family Haven offers quality and private shelter for homeless families in Grand Rapids. Five apartments accommodate homeless families free of charge for up to 30 days.

Family Haven gives families hope by providing them with the opportunity, structure and compassion to stabilize their lives. During their stay, families work with staff to identify and solve the issues that led to homelessness. Family Haven also offers:

- Financial counseling
- Employment assistance
- Clothing pantry
- Food pantry
- Children's activities
- Bible study

Even after a family leaves, Family Haven's services remain available to them. Staff continues to act as an advocate for each family to ensure they remain in permanent housing.
